Simple Turkey Chili

"This is a very simple and hearty chili with plenty of flavor. It's even better the second day! I serve this with lowfat Cheddar cheese and lowfat sour cream. It's also delicious with crackers."

Ingredients:

1-1/2 teaspoons olive oil	1 (16 ounce) can canned kidney	1/2 teaspoon dried oregano
, .		, 1
1 pound ground turkey	beans - drained, rinsed, and	1/2 teaspoon ground cayenne pepper
1 onion, chopped	mashed	1/2 teaspoon ground cumin
2 cups water	1 tablespoon garlic, minced	1/2 teaspoon salt
1 (28 ounce) can canned crushed	2 tablespoons chili powder	1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
tomatoes	1/2 teaspoon paprika	

Directions:

Heat the oil in a large pot over medium heat. Place turkey in the pot, and cook until evenly brown. Stir in onion, and cook until tender.

Pour water into the pot. Mix in tomatoes, kidney beans, and garlic. Season chili powder, paprika, oregano, cayenne pepper, cumin, salt, and pepper. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat to low, cover, and simmer 30 minutes.
